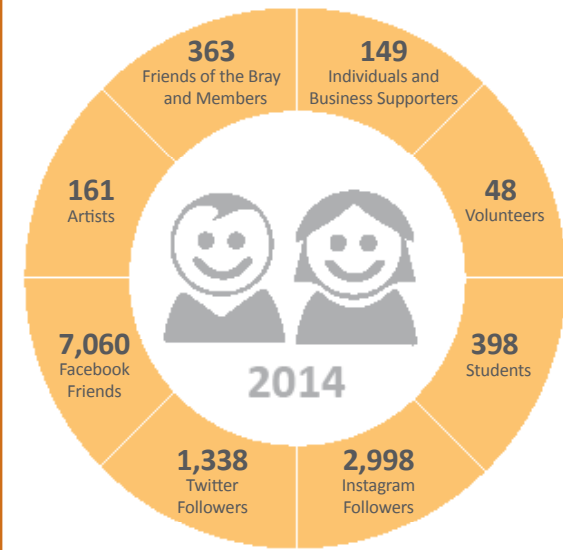

**COLLECTORS** and appreciators of art discovered new voices and creative work being done in ceramics.

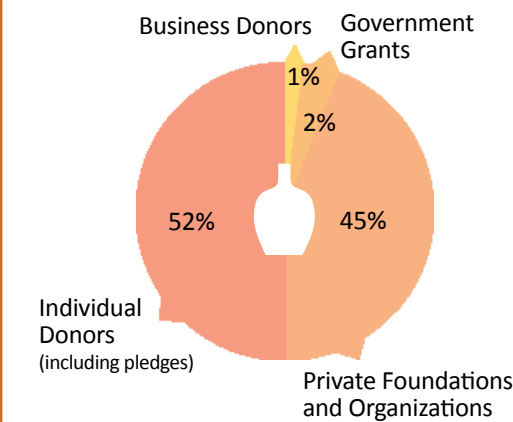
**DONORS** and **VOLUNTEERS** supported their passion for ceramics in a meaningful way.

The local **HELENA COMMUNITY** shared one of the country's leading arts institutions and historical treasures with friends, family and guests.

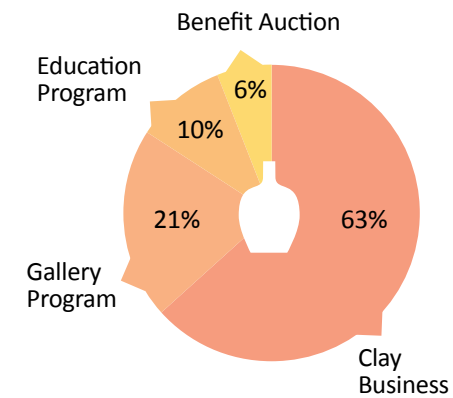
## REVENUE

**Contributed Revenue: \$1,675,358**



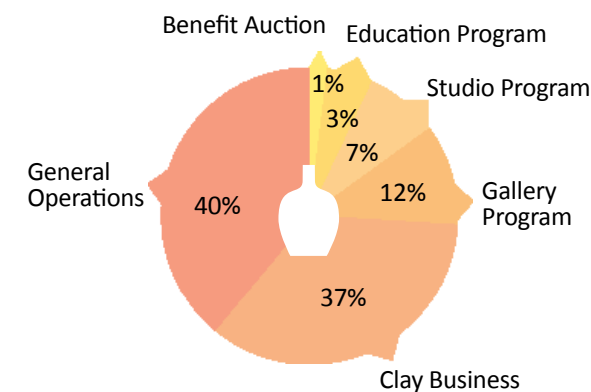
**Earned Revenue: \$929,362**
